

Draw Conclusions from a Map

TRY THE SKILL

The map to the right shows the path or route that ancient people took from Asia to North America and South America. You can use this map to draw conclusions. For example, you can see that the people who followed this route moved from north to south. You might conclude that they were looking for warmer lands where they could find more food.

Study the map and decide which conclusion in each group makes the most sense.

1. Ⓐ All of the people who followed this route ended up in South America.

Ⓑ The people who ended up in South America had been there before and knew they wanted to live there.

Ⓒ The people who ended up in South America were probably the grandchildren of those who started this journey.
2. Ⓐ The people who took this route had to break through a glacier to make a path.

Ⓑ People followed this route because it took them between the glaciers.

Ⓒ The great number of migrating people caused part of the glacier to melt.
